BY-LAW NO. 2017-003

A by-law to repeal Board By-law 96-4, a By-law to provide policy in accordance with The Regional Municipality of Halton Act for the Halton Regional Police Service

WHEREAS on the 24th of April 1996, The Regional Municipality of Halton Police Services Board enacted and passed By-law 96-4 to establish a mandatory retirement age of sixty-five (65) for civilian members;

AND WHEREAS it has been subsequently determined that the establishment and enforcement of such a mandatory retirement age is likely contrary to the *Human Rights Code* R.S.O. 1990, c. H.19;

NOW THEREFORE The Regional Municipality of Halton Police Services Board enacts as follows:

- 1. Halton Regional Police Services Board By-Law 96-4 is hereby repealed.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force on the day it is passed.

This by-law is hereby enacted by The Regional Municipality of Halton Regional Police Services Board on the 23 day of March, 2017.
