## 1. Crime Prevention (pursuant to O. Reg. 3/99 and PSM Guideline CP-002)

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Board that crime prevention policing initiatives be provided within the Region.
- 1.2 To support this policy, the Chief of Police shall:
  - a) identify the need, and recommend service delivery options as part of the Business Plan process required by B-AI-001, for community-based crime prevention initiatives based on crime, call and public disorder analysis, criminal intelligence, road safety and community needs;
  - b) ensure that the Service works, where possible, with municipalities, school boards, community organizations, neighbourhoods, business and neighbouring municipalities or jurisdictions to develop and implement community-based crime prevention initiatives;
  - c) designate a Member to have overall responsibility for the Service's involvement in community-based crime prevention initiatives; and
  - d) establish procedures on crime prevention initiatives.
