1. Communications and Dispatch (pursuant to O. Reg. 3/99 and PSM Guideline LE-002

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Board to provide for its own communications and dispatch services.
- 1.2 To support this policy, the Chief of Police shall:
 - a) ensure that 24 hours a day a Member of the Service is available to supervise police communications and dispatch services;
 - b) ensure that Officers on patrol have a portable two-way voice communication capability that allows the Officers to be in contact with the communications centre when away from their vehicle or on foot patrol;
 - c) establish procedures and processes on communications and dispatch services; and
 - d) ensure that members who provide communications and dispatch services meet the requirements of the Adequacy Standards Regulation.
