1. Prisoner Care and Control (pursuant to O. Reg. 3/99 and PSM Guideline No. LE-016)

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Board that the Service ensure that proper care and control of prisoners is provided.
- 1.2 To support this policy, the Chief of Police shall:
 - a) establish procedures and processes for:
 - i) the care and control of prisoners, including effective monitoring; and
 - ii) responding to an escape from police custody;
 - b) ensure that Members involved in prisoner care and control have the knowledge, skills and abilities required to perform this function; and
 - c) following an escape or in-custody death, review the procedures, processes and practices of the Service for prisoner care and control and report back to the Board.
