## 1. Stolen or Smuggled Firearms (pursuant to O. Reg. 3/99 and PSM Guideline No. LE-019)

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Board that investigations into stolen or smuggled firearms are undertaken and managed.
- 1.2 To support this policy, the Chief of Police shall develop and maintain procedures and processes:
  - a) that requires that every firearm that comes into the possession of the Service will be checked to determine whether the firearm:
    - i) has been reported stolen or lost;
    - ii) is legally registered in Canada; or
    - iii) is smuggled;
  - b) on the investigation of stolen or smuggled firearms in accordance with the Service's Criminal Investigation Management Plan; and
  - c) that addresses the sharing of crime analysis, criminal intelligence and other information on stolen or smuggled firearms with relevant law enforcement agencies and as required by section 134(8)4 of the *Police Services Act*.
