1. Supervision (pursuant to O. Reg. 3/99 and PSM Guideline No. LE-025)

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Board that adequate supervision be provided to the Members of the Service.
- 1.2 To support this policy, the Chief of Police shall:
 - a) ensure that there is 24 hour supervision available to Members of the Service;
 - establish procedures on supervision that set out the circumstances where a Supervisor must be contacted and when a Supervisor must be present at an incident, including for all major case incidents; and
 - establish a selection process to ensure that Members appointed permanently to supervisory positions have the knowledge, skills and abilities required for the supervisory positions.
