1. <u>Parental and Non-parental Abductions and Attempts (pursuant to O. Reg. 3/99 and PSM</u> <u>Guideline No. LE-040)</u>

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Board to ensure that investigations into parental and non-parental abductions and attempted abductions are undertaken and managed.
- 1.2 To support this policy, the Chief of Police shall:
 - a) develop and maintain procedures that require that investigations into parental/familial abductions and attempted abductions be undertaken in accordance with the Service's Criminal Investigation Management Plan; and
 - b) develop and maintain procedures that require that investigations into non-parental/nonfamilial abductions and attempted abductions be undertaken in accordance with the procedures set out in the Ministry's designated *Ontario Major Case Management Manual*.
