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1. **Police Action at Labour Disputes (pursuant to O. Reg. 3/99 and PSM Guideline No. PO-002)**
- 1.1 It is the policy of the Board with respect to police action at labour disputes, the role of the Police is to preserve the peace, prevent offences, and enforce the law including offences against persons and property in accordance with the powers and discretion available to an Officer under the law.
- 1.2 To support this policy, the Chief of Police shall establish procedures on:
  - a) the role of the police at a labour dispute;
  - b) providing information to management, labour and the public on police procedures during a labour dispute; and
  - c) secondary employment under section 49 of the *Act* and labour disputes.
